TERMS AND CONDITIONS (Please disseminate to all your "Guns")

1. Shooting will be for teams of 'guns' as agreed, with assembly at Glemham Hall by 9.10 am each shoot day for a 9.20 am briefing and a 9.30 am prompt start, unless otherwise agreed. **A 'collection/sweep' will be taken for The Campaign for Shooting or The Game & Wildlife Conservation Trust or British Association for Shooting & Conservation.**
2. A midday or end of day luncheon in The Hall will be provided in the cost, including alcoholic sustenance.
3. It is the intention of the GHE to give the best possible sport available in traditional surroundings and to ensure that the shooting will be as evenly distributed as possible to make for everyone's enjoyment. 8 x rounds of non-lead shot (except steel) should be carried by each 'gun' for duck, snipe, coot, moorhen and golden plover. Guns to be carried unloaded in slips between drives.
4. **It is the 'gun's' responsibility to make sure that he/she is both experienced and competent and, above all, safe in the handling and operation of the shotgun in his/her possession and that the recognised shooting etiquette is strictly observed to ensure maximum possible enjoyment by all. Novice/inexperienced 'guns' must be accompanied by a competent instructor/minder. The wearing of ear defenders and eye protection is strongly recommended.**
5. **'Guns' are required to carry full third party liability insurance cover and to be in possession of a current Shotgun Certificate/Overseas Visitors' Certificate and are encouraged to be members of a recognised Field Sports Organisation. No liability shall be accepted by the GHE in respect of death, injury, illness, damage or accident to person(s) or property, however arising, to person(s) who enter on the 'shoot' entirely at their own risk.**
6. Insurance for shoot cancellation/personal liability cover is a group and/or individual responsibility.
7. The 'bag' takes into account 'guns' of average ability and weather. Sufficient drives will be planned to produce a reasonable bag, but 'guns' being over selective or not taking reasonable opportunities will not be compensated or have extra drives. 'Guns' are asked to mark downed birds carefully, pick what they can and collect up empty cartridge cases. Only fibre wad or photo-degradable cartridges are to be used.
8. **A deposit, (non-refundable), as stated in the Shoot Brochure, will be required when confirming a booking to reserve desired date; the balance to be paid in full 30 days prior to shoot day(s), when names of 'guns' should also be forwarded so that Shoot Cards can be prepared. Invoices will be sent, cheques payable to "Glemham Hall Estate". Any excess for game and/or lunch on the day will be invoiced. A leeway of 6% above or below the expected bag will be taken into account in determining whether a refund or excess charge is due. Prior to determining whether a refund is due, account will be taken of the number of shots fired; a ratio of 3:1 will be used in the calculation.**
9. The price will include provision for beaters. The only other cost, on top of the price paid, will be normal gratuities to the Head Keeper. Each 'gun' will receive a brace of birds in feather at the end of each shooting day.
10. **NO ground game, ie foxes, hares, rabbits, wounded game to be shot unless otherwise agreed. NO protected bird or animal species are to be shot.**
